Instructions: Complete this section if the student’s parent(s) filed or will file a 2023 income tax return with the IRS. *As part of federal student aid eligibility, parents are required to consent and approve sharing and importing income and tax information from the IRS to the FAFSA form, even if the attempt to obtain or use such data is ineffective. In most cases, no further documentation is needed to verify 2023 tax information directly from the IRS.*

If 2023 income tax return information for the parent(s) was not available or could not be used, the parent(s) must provide the institution with a 2023 IRS Tax Return Transcript(s) or a freshly signed copy of the 2023 federal income tax return and applicable schedules. To obtain an IRS tax return transcript, go to www.irs.gov and click on the “Get Your Tax Record” link, or call 1-800-908-9946. Make sure to request the “IRS tax return transcript” and **NOT** the “IRS tax account transcript.” You will need your Social Security Number, date of birth, and the address on file with the IRS (normally this will be the address used when the 2023 IRS tax return was filed).
